

HOW TO APPLY:

1. International applicants can be enrolled to the MA program Languages & Cultures of Africa on **a fee-paying basis only**.

2. Applicants may apply (submit application) and upload all needed documents online (**see the list of documents required bellow**)

3. Make sure that you have your Russian Visa (see the HOW DO I GET MY RUSSIAN VISA? section bellow)

4. Applicants should have practical English skills at level B2 or more.

THE LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

- a copy of an identity document with the indication of his/her nationality (the following pages must be scanned: the applicant's photograph, surname, given name, patronymic, gender, date and place of birth, nationality, document series and number, information about the issuing governmental agency and the applicant's place of registration);
- an application for admission to MA program presented filled in the applicant's Personal Account and signed by the applicant;

HOW DO I GET MY RUSSIAN VISA?

Remember to submit your visa application **in advance** if you are applying for a fee-paying program and require an entry visa.

Note that **processing time** for a **visa invitation** is up to 2 months.

- the applicant's photograph (taken in the current calendar year, with vertical resolution of at least 800 pixels and horizontal resolution of at least 600 pixels);
- a standard educational credential;
- documents for participation in the competitive selection of portfolios (see WHAT DOES A PORTFOLIO INCLUDE part bellow);

All the documents must be scanned and attached to the registration form through the applicant's Personal Account

Step 1: Fill in an application for a visa invitation and upload it to your Personal Account

Step 2: Get the original copy of the invitation

Step 3: Get your visa from the Russian Embassy in your country

WHAT DOES A PORTFOLIO INCLUDE?

Mandatory documents: a motivation letter (*Why this MA program was chosen?*) and an essay (*What is the field of my scientific interests?*).

Additional documents: international language certificates (confirming knowledge of English at the required level); academic publications; certificates of participation in student scientific competitions, conferences and research projects; study abroad certificates.

The maximum score is \geq 100 points.

APPLYING TIPS FOR YOUR ON-LINE APPLYING PROCEDURE

1. Create a Personal Account https://cabinet.spbu.ru

2. Fill in an Application Form in your Personal Account

3. Create and Upload a **Portfolio** to your Personal Account.

Required documents are listed above.

4. If you have successfully completed the application process and succeeded in **portfolio** competition, the only thing left is just to **sign the Agreement on Education**.
